These are exciting times for our youth and young adults within the South England Conference (SEC), many of whom are professionals, students, entrepreneurs, the challenge, 'Evangelism, Everyone, Everywhere'.

Despite the massive potential among the future leaders of our church this is also the age group we are haemorrhaging within our church family at an alarming rate. In 2009, a survey was published which focused on this age group where the results were published in the book Already Gone. Its results are based on young adults, millennials (those born between the 1980s and 2000), who grew up in the church but had left the church in their 20s. It indicated that the majority of this drop-out trend occurred during college age. It notes that '61% of today's young adults who were regular church attendees are now "spiritually disengaged". They are not actively attending church, praying, or reading their Bibles.'

It is a priority of the SEC Youth Ministries (YM) to empower, retain, re-engage, and reclaim this generation, encouraging them not only to realise their identity in Jesus Christ, but to realise their unique gifts and calling as Seventh-day Adventist Christians, not only for the benefit of themselves, but to become disciples, leading and mentoring the younger ones in ministry and those within their sphere of influence.

Over this year we have travelled across the SEC, meeting with around 200 youth leaders and workers, including ministers and elders across the SEC, and have compiled youth data as part of the 50\*7 project that will help the YM scratch where the youth are actually itching.

We have continued to work with and support the elected Youth Federation

presidents in working to revive, retain and train our youth. Each area has been represented by Area 2: Shellon Rodney, Area 3: Mphathisi Ncube (MP) & Sheiris Vaval, Area 5: TVYF Cheryl Singo, Area 6: LYF Shereen Rodney, Area 7: Seimone Gunter and Area 8: Cynthia Chigodo. Area 1 is being well taken care of by Frontier Evangelist Steve Hulbert. We give God thanks for their willingness to serve.

2017 has been a learning year as we cross over into 2018. I am proud of each area federation, youth leader, minister, parent and youth for making 2017 the year that it was. Despite the challenges faced, our leaders and local youth have risen to the challenge and have aimed to benefit and support the youth where they serve. As we reflect and give God thanks for 2017 there is high expectation in the air that God will move among the youth and young adults of the SEC, creating a revival that has never been seen before for 2018.






