- Mal 3:9 Ye are <u>cursed</u> with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation.
- 3. <u>Mal 3:10</u> <u>Bring</u> ye all the <u>tithes</u> into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a <u>blessing</u>, that *there shall* not *be room* enough *to receive it*.

Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. 2 Corinthians 9:7



Her heart was full of love to give because..



We call this type of generous Giving: Sacrifice An offering of Sacrifice


She didn't have to give it, but she wanted to be Cheerful Giver to God...


