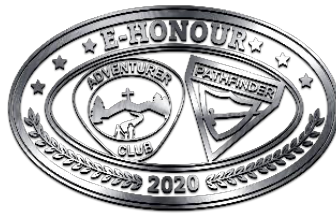


Photo Fun British Union e-Award
