Choose an area that you would like to observe.

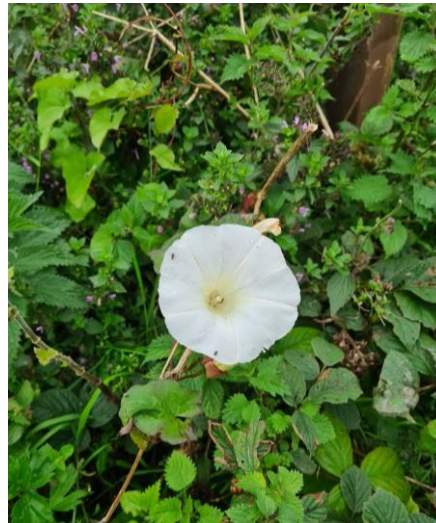
- Choose a time for example I choose evening time 8 pm and the back garden.

On what day did God create the plants and trees?

- **Genesis 1:11-13 ICB**

- ¹¹ Then God said, “Let the earth produce plants. Some plants will make grain for seeds. Others will make fruit with seeds in it. Every seed will produce more of its own kind of plant.” And it happened. ¹² The earth produced plants. Some plants had grain for seeds. The trees made fruit with seeds in it. Each seed grew its own kind of plant. God saw that all this was good. ¹³ Evening passed, and morning came. This was the third day.

On what day did God create your habitat?

- When were the birds of the sky and the creatures of the sea created?
- Genesis 1:20, 21 & 23 ICB
- ²⁰ Then God said, “Let the water be filled with living things. And let birds fly in the air above the earth.”
- ²¹ So God created the large sea animals. He created every living thing that moves in the sea. The sea is filled with these living things. Each one produces more of its own kind. God also made every bird that flies. And each bird produces more of its own kind. God saw that this was good.
- ²³ Evening passed, and morning came. This was the fifth day.

On what day did God create the animals?

- **Genesis 1:25,26 & 31 ICB**

- ²⁵ So God made the wild animals, the tame animals and all the small crawling animals to produce more of their own kind. God saw that this was good.
- ²⁶ Then God said, “Let us make human beings in our image and likeness. And let them rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky. Let them rule over the tame animals, over all the earth and over all the small crawling animals on the earth.”

- ³¹ God looked at everything he had made, and it was very good. Evening passed, and morning came. This was the sixth day.

Describe what you think the habitat of heaven would look like ?

- Isaiah 65:17-25 ICB
- ¹⁷ “Look, I will make new heavens and a new earth.
And people will not remember the past.
They will not think about those things.
²¹ In that city the person who builds a house will live there.
The person who plants vineyards will get to eat grapes.



- ²² No more will one person build a house and someone else live there.
One person will not plant a garden and someone else eat its fruit.
My people will live a long time
as trees live long.
My chosen people will live there
and enjoy the things they make.
²⁵ Wolves and lambs will eat together in peace.
Lions will eat hay like oxen.
A snake on the ground will not hurt anyone.
They will not hurt or destroy each other
on all my holy mountain,”
says the Lord.

Revelation 22:1-5

- **22** Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life. The river was shining like crystal. It flows from the throne of God and of the Lamb ² down the middle of the street of the city. The tree of life was on each side of the river. It produces fruit 12 times a year, once each month. The leaves of the tree are for the healing of all people.

- ³ Nothing that God judges guilty will be in that city. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be there. And God's servants will worship him. ⁴ They will see his face, and his name will be written on their foreheads. ⁵ There will never be night again. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun. The Lord God will give them light. And they will rule like kings forever and ever.

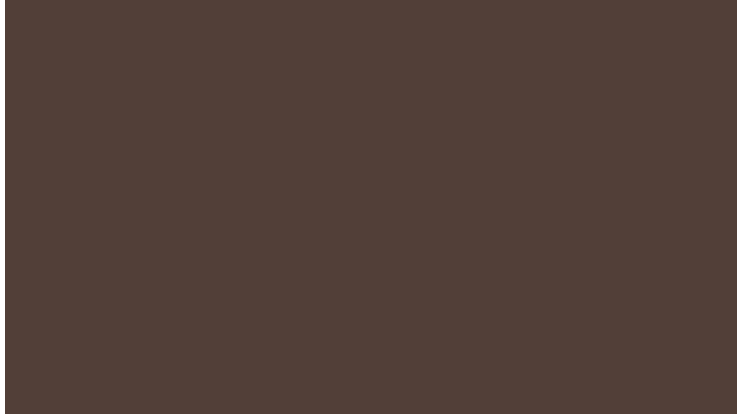
