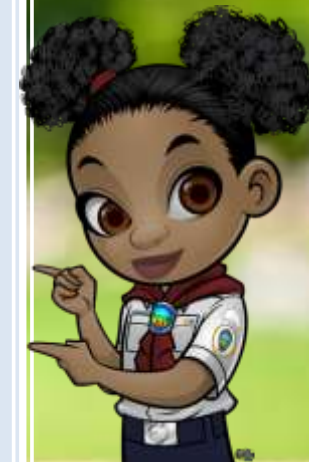

- **Avoid studying your Bible while eating food or drinking.**





Requirement 2

- **Keep your Bible in a safe place**
- **Keep your Bible out of direct sunlight**
- **Avoid bending the cover backwards to easily access just one page.**
- **Don't stuff bulletins and other materials between Bible pages.**
