
- Tabernacle means a moveable dwelling.

- God wanted to dwell among his people, the Israelites. He wanted to meet them in a special place.










What does the gate symbolise?

The gate was the only way in to the tabernacle, just like


Jesus is the only way.









THE COURTYARD

There were two things in the courtyard.


- · The Altar of Sacrifice
- The Laver





THE ALTAR OF SACRIFICE

- The altar was made of acacia (shittim) wood and covered with bronze.
- The spotless animals were sacrificed on the altar.
- Sacrifice: we give up something really important in order to get something better.



THE LAVER


- This was a basin filled with water
- The priests used the basin to wash themselves before going into the Holy place.
- God was telling us that we need to be clean on the outside, but also on the inside.



THE HOLY PLACE

There were three things in the Holy Place;

- 7 branched candlestick
- Table of shewbread
- Altar of incense



LAMPSTAND

- It is also called the Menorah.
- It was made out of one piece of gold.
- The ends of the branches contained pure olive oil; used as fuel.
- God told the priests to never let the the light go out so it was always lit.
- God wants us to remember that Jesus is the main branch and we are the believers, the other branches.



TABLE OF SHEWBREAD

- A small table made of acaia
 wood. It was covered with gold.
- It held twelve loaves. The priests baked it using fine flour.
- Only the priests could eat the bread on Sabbath.
- It was God's way of saying He wants to fellowship with us.



ALTAR OF INCENSE

- It was smaller than the Brazen Altar.
- God asked the priests to burn incense, a special perfume, on the altar every morning and evening.
- The incense was like our prayers going up to God.



THE VEIL

- · A thick curtain made of fine linen
- Separated the Holy Place from the Most Holy Place
- · It had angels embroidered on it
- In Hebrew the word veil means screen, divider or separator.
- When Jesus died the veil split from top to bottom



THE MOST HOLY PLACE

 This contained the Ark of the Covenant

 It was made of Acacia wood, covered with gold.

 There were two angels on top.



ARK OF COVENANT

- It was in 2 parts
 - The Mercy Seat
 - The Ark of the Covenant
- Inside it were 3 things;
 - a golden pot of manna,
 - Aaron's rod that budded
 - The two tablets of stone (Ten Commandments)








MAKE A TABERNACLE
