At Home

What rules do you have at home to help you stay safe?

- Don't play with matches
- Don't run with scissors
- Wash your hands before eating
- Don't put toys in your mouth
- Close cupboard doors

- Don't eat wild berries (unless a responsible adult tells you they're safe

- Wear warm layers
- Wear Sunscreen

- Don't take things from strangers (gifts, lifts, etc.)
- Don't go off with a stranger
- Know your name, phone number and address
