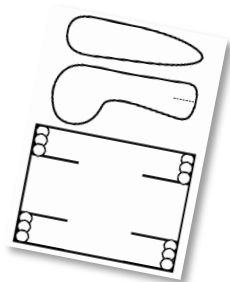
 Printed Image on Green Cardstock paper

Or Print in white and color it green before the meeting

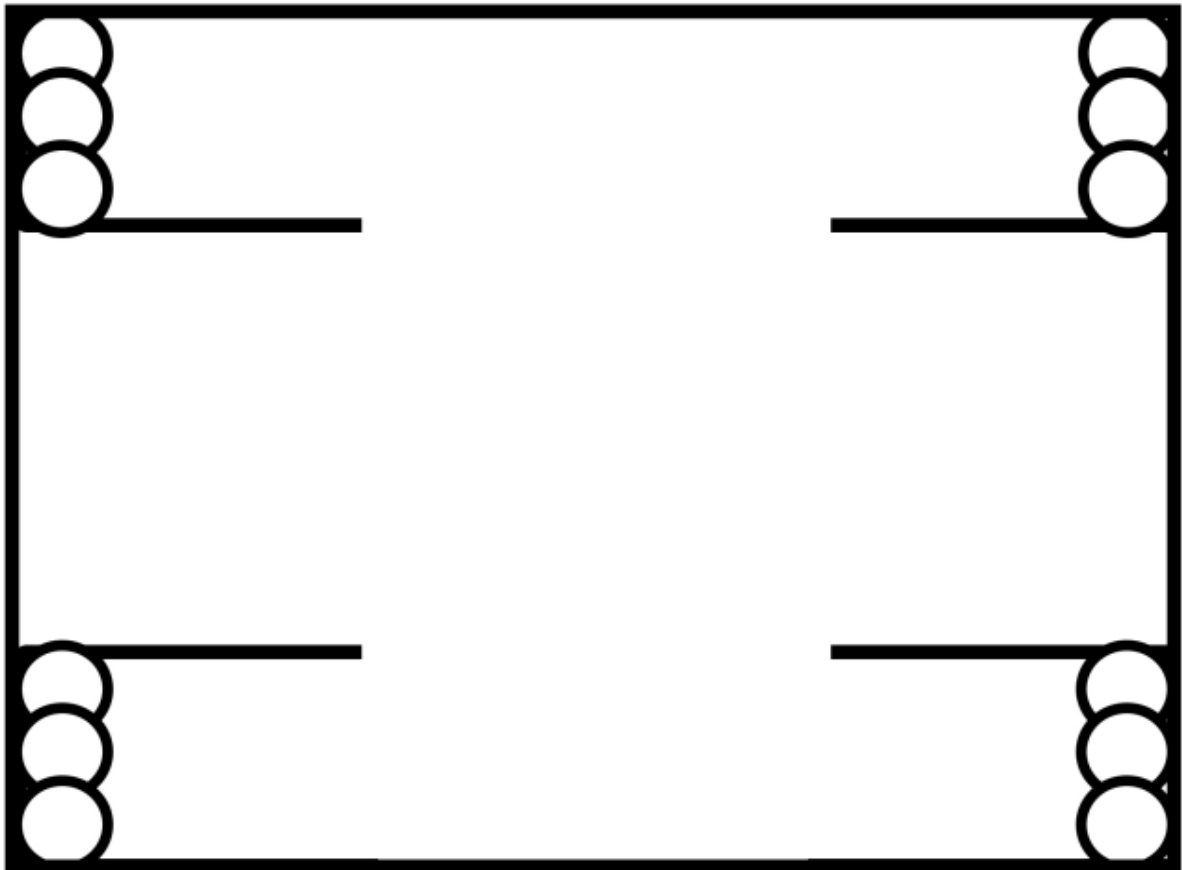
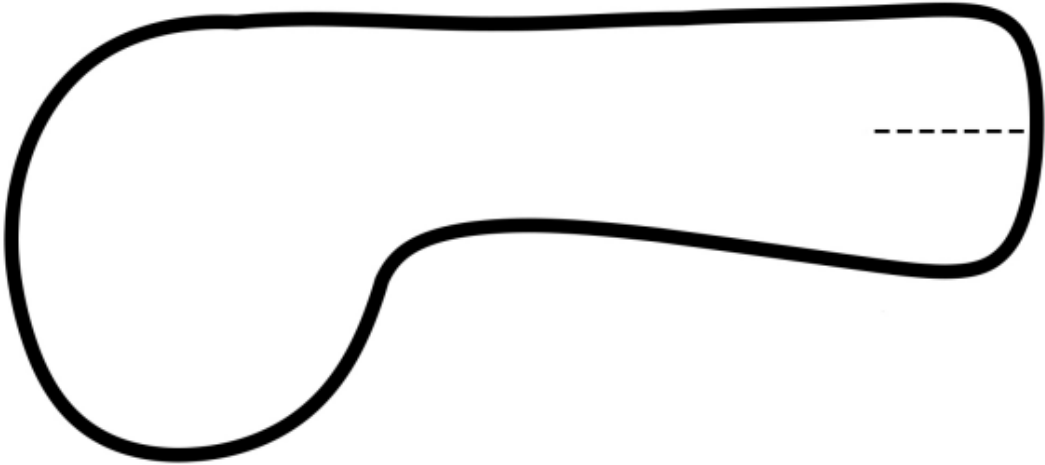
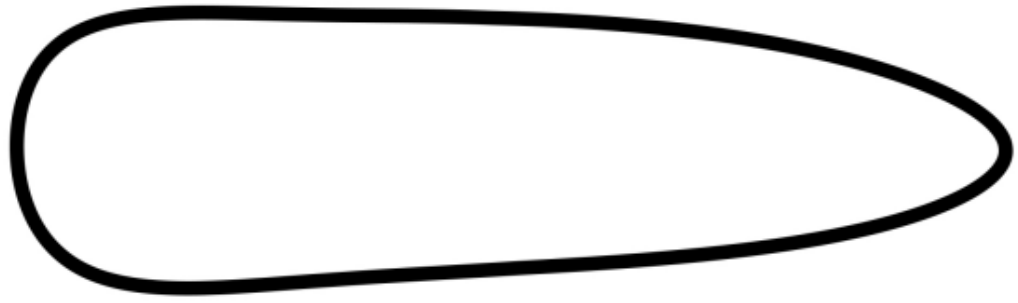
 Glue stick

Print Wheel on Cardstock paper (next page)

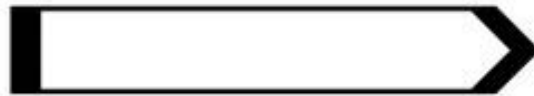
Add Arrow

HIDE DINOSAUR FIGURES OR WORD CARDS AROUND A ROOM OR OUTDOOR PLAY AREA.

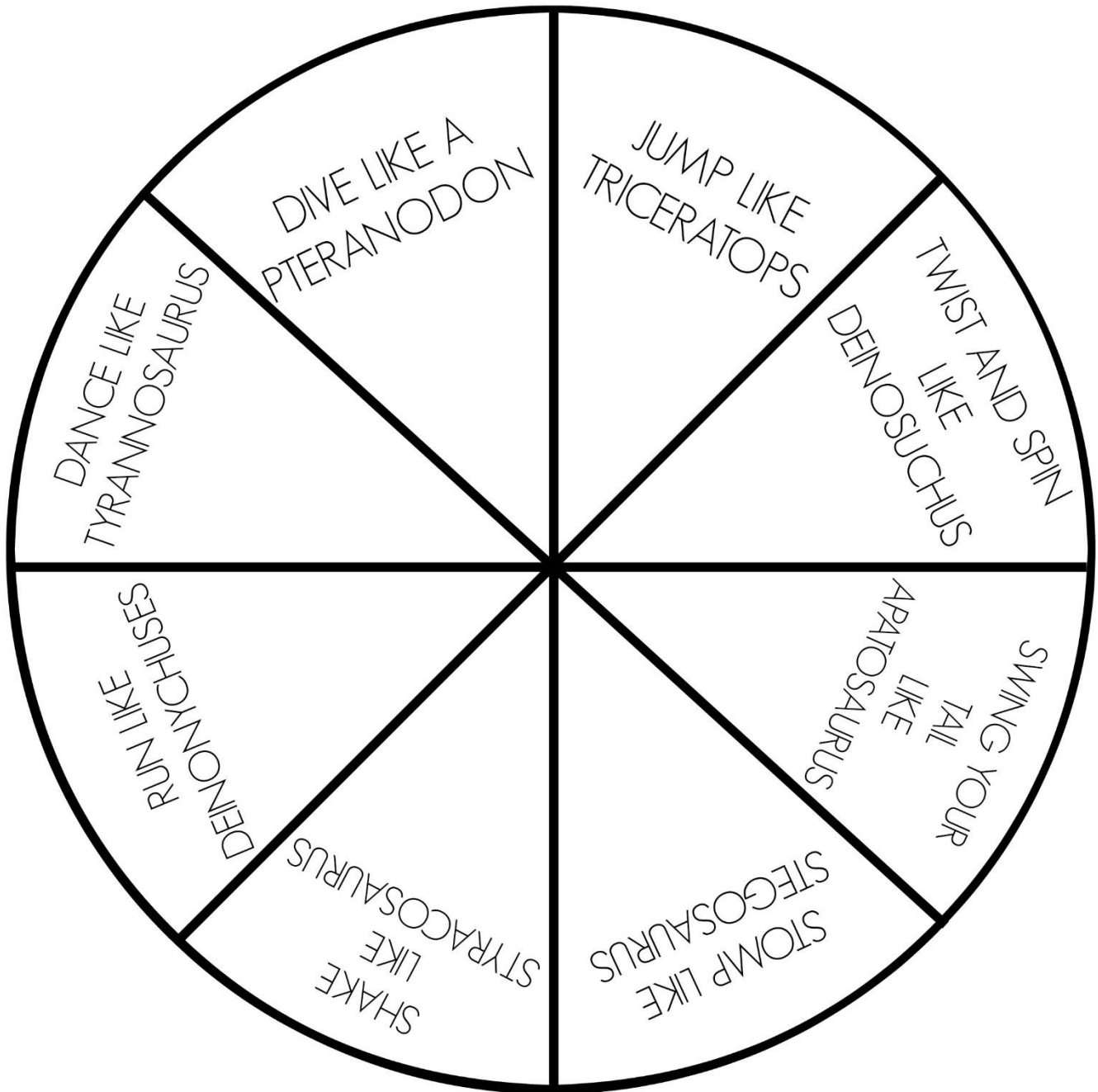
SPIN THE ARROW ON THE GAME BOARD.

EXTRA ACTIVITIES TO TRY WITH YOUR ADVENTURER



Salt dough fossils

1 cup salt
2 cups flour
1 cup lukewarm water

Mix together, imprint with small dinosaur toy and write name with toothpick. Bake for one hour at 375F (190C)

Dinosaur Fossil Dig

Container

Sand -(5 part fine sand, 3 part cornstarch, 1 part baby oil or cooking oil)
example: 2.5 cups of fine sand, 1.5 cups of cornstarch, .5 cups of oil.

Toy Dinosaurs

Small brush
